Koinonia-Relationships Week 2 Scriptures

1 John 1:6-7 TPT

(6) If we claim that we **share life** with him, but keep walking in the realm of darkness, we're fooling ourselves and not living the truth. (7) But if we keep **living in the pure light** that surrounds him, **we share unbroken fellowship** with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, continually cleanses us from all sin.

1 Corinthian 2:16 AMPC

...But we have the mind of Christ (the Messiah) and do hold the thoughts (feelings and purposes) of His heart.

Isaiah 55:7-9 TPT

(7) The wicked need to abandon their ways, and sinful ones need to banish every evil thought. Let them return to Yahweh, and they will experience his compassionate mercy. Yes, let them return to God, for he will lavish forgiveness upon them. (8) "For my thoughts *about mercy* are not like your thoughts, and my ways are different from yours. (9) As high as the heavens are above the earth, so my ways and my thoughts are higher than yours.

1 Peter 5:8-11 AMP

(8) Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert and cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour. (9) But resist him, be firm in your faith [against his attack—rooted, established, immovable], knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being experienced by your brothers and sisters throughout the world. [You do not suffer alone.] (10) After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace [who imparts His blessing and favor], who called you to His own eternal glory in Christ, will Himself complete, confirm, strengthen, and establish you [making you what you ought to be]. (11) To Him be dominion (power, authority, sovereignty) forever and ever. Amen.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 AMP

(3) For though we walk in the flesh [as mortal men], we are not carrying on our [spiritual] warfare according to the flesh and using the weapons of man. (4) The weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood]. Our weapons are divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. (5) **We are destroying sophisticated arguments and every exalted and proud thing that**

sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought and purpose captive to the obedience of Christ, (6) being ready to punish every act of disobedience, when your own obedience [as a church] is complete.

Exodus 34:5-7 AMPC

(5) And the Lord descended in the cloud and stood with him there and proclaimed the name of the Lord. (6) And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord! the Lord! a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abundant in loving-kindness and truth, (7) Keeping mercy and loving-kindness for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but Who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children, to the third and fourth generation.

Exodus 34:5-7 MSG

(5) GOD descended in the cloud and took up his position there beside him and called out the name, GOD. (6) GOD passed in front of him and called out, "GOD, GOD, a God of mercy and grace, endlessly patient—so much love, so deeply true— (7) loyal in love for a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, rebellion, and sin. Still, he doesn't ignore sin. He holds sons and grandsons responsible for a father's sins to the third and even fourth generation."

Romans 8:6-8 AMPC

(6) Now the mind of the flesh [which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit] is death [death that comprises all the miseries arising from sin, both here and hereafter]. But the mind of the [Holy] Spirit is life and [soul] peace [both now and forever]. (7) [That is] because the mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot. (8) So then those who are living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please or satisfy God, or be acceptable to Him.
